

13+ ART SCHOLARSHIP

The 13+ Art Scholarships will be awarded to top performing students entering Upper 4 (Year 9). The awards are made to students who make an outstanding contribution to Art, and who show evidence of further potential together with a lively interest in the subject.

The awards are conditional upon the recipient's active and full participation in the sporting life of the school. Scholars should be enthusiastic ambassadors for sport throughout the school.

Eligibility: These awards are available to external candidates entering Upper 4 (Year 9) and take effect from the beginning of the Upper 4 academic year. The scholarships are expected to be valid until the end of the Sixth Form (Year 13).

Candidates may only apply for one type of scholarship.

Selection Process: Candidates are required to submit a portfolio of their work with a maximum of six pieces, together with a sketchbook and this application form. Please also provide a letter of support/reference from your Art Teacher. Candidates will then be invited to meet with Mrs Vingoe, the Head of Art, to discuss their interests, experiences and ambitions. They will also be given a drawing task to complete.

Application Deadline: Friday 12 January 2018

The completed application form should be sent to the Admissions Office by this date. Further details and a timetable will be forwarded to all candidates.
