WHAT IS MOOTING?



A moot court simulates a court hearing, in which participants analyse a problem, research the relevant law, prepare written evidence, and present oral argument. Moot problems are often controversial, unsettled or have recently been in the news.....

The simulation imitates that followed in real courts: the judge enters, the mooters and the judge bow to each other, the clerk announces the matter, the mooters give their evidence, the judge asks questions, the court adjourns, and the judge then returns to deliver a brief judgment and some feedback. Exeter University Law students will help and advise you during the whole process!

Mooting has been part of the process of training lawyers for centuries and would be a brilliant skill to talk about on your CV or application for university.....so give it a go! It is going to be lots of fun!
