#### Earn and learn

As soon as you start work as an apprentice, you will start earning a competitive salary, learn new skills, and be on your way to gaining the qualifications you'll need to be successful in your role and support your future career progression.

#### How long is it?

5 years.

#### How do I qualify?

A minimum of 3 A levels or expected at grade C or higher, with a minimum of 112 UCAS points. A minimum of 5 GCSEs grades A\* to C or equivalent grades 9 - 4, including English and Maths grade A or grade 6. Or Level 3 apprenticeship in a construction discipline.

#### Is there an age limit?

You must be 17 years old or above to apply, with no upper age limit.

#### What will I study?

You will study for a BSC (Hons) in Quantity Surveying, accredited by the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors.

#### How will I combine study and work?

You'll study for your degree at university on a day release basis, for 5 years. Supplementing your learning with on-the-job training in all aspects of Commercial Management and Quantity Surveying.

# What are the benefits of combining work and study?

Working and studying in a civil engineering and infrastructure environment, you're in the ideal place to acquire the skills and knowledge over those 5 years, to sit your Assessment of Professional Competence (APC) and final assessment to become a RICS Chartered Quantity Surveyor. Highways England will pay your degree tuition fees and provide study support throughout.

#### What qualification will I get at the end of it?

- BSc (Hons) in Quantity Surveying
- Chartered Member status of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors (with the letters MRICS after your name)
