

## 13+ ART SCHOLARSHIP

**The 13+ Art Scholarships** will be awarded to top performing students entering Upper 4 (Year 9). The awards are made to students who make an outstanding contribution to Art, and who show evidence of further potential together with a lively interest in the subject.

The awards are conditional upon the recipient's active and full participation in art at the school. Scholars should be enthusiastic ambassadors for art throughout the school.

**Eligibility:** These awards are available to external candidates entering Upper 4 (Year 9) and take effect from the beginning of the Upper 4 academic year. The scholarships are expected to be valid until the end of the Sixth Form (Year 13).

#### CANDIDATES MAY APPLY FOR ONE SCHOLARSHIP ONLY.

#### **Selection Process:**

- 1. Candidates are required to submit a portfolio of their work with a maximum of six pieces, together with a sketchbook and this application form. Please also provide a letter of support/reference from your Art Teacher.
- 2. A short interview with Mrs Vingoe, the Head of Art, to discuss their interests, experiences and ambitions.
- 3. Candidates will perform a drawing task.
- 4. An interview with the Headmistress to discuss interests.

### Application Deadline: Friday 10 January 2020

The completed application form should be sent to the Admissions Office by 10 January 2020. Further details and a timetable will be forwarded to all candidates.
