

13+ DANCE SCHOLARSHIP

The 13+ Dance Scholarships will be awarded to top performing students entering Upper 4 (Year 9). The awards are made to students who make an outstanding contribution to Dance, and who show evidence of further potential together with a lively interest in the subject.

The awards are conditional upon the recipient's active and full participation in dance at the school. Scholars should be enthusiastic ambassadors for dance throughout the school.

Eligibility: These awards are available to external candidates entering Upper 4 (Year 9) and take effect from the beginning of the Upper 4 academic year. The scholarships are expected to be valid until the end of the Sixth Form (Year 13).

CANDIDATES MAY APPLY FOR ONE SCHOLARSHIP ONLY.

Selection Process: Candidates should arrive wearing suitable clothing over the top of their dance clothes and bring any accompanying music required with them. (Please indicate on the application form whether a CD player will be required.)

- 1. Candidates will be asked to perform two contrasting dance pieces of their choice, lasting no more than 2 minutes each.
- 2. Candidates will have an interview with Mrs Caroline Leigh, Deputy Head, in which they will discuss their interests, experiences and ambitions.
- 3. An interview with the Headmistress to discuss interests.

Application Deadline: Friday 10 January 2020

The completed application form should be sent to the Admissions Office by Friday 10 January. Further details of the audition arrangements and timetable will be forwarded to all candidates.
