

11+ AND 13+ SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

Scholarships are worth 10% of school fees awarded to top performing students. Scholars must make an outstanding contribution to the school in their chosen area and be all round good ambassadors.

Selection for an 11+ or 13+ Academic Scholarship will be purely based on the Entrance Assessment.

Further 11+ and 13+ Scholarships are available to external candidates for Sport, Music, Drama and Art.

For Sport, Music, Drama and Art, selection will be based on an interview and, where relevant, an audition. Candidates are encouraged to put together a portfolio to illustrate their achievements to date.

11+ Scholarship & Awards Day on 27 January 2021.

13+ Scholarship Interview Day on 29 January 2021.

Art Scholarships Selection Process:

- 1. Candidates are required to submit a portfolio of their work with a maximum of six pieces, together with a sketchbook and this application form. Please also provide a letter of support/reference from your Art Teacher.
- 2. A short interview with the Head of Art, to discuss their interests, experiences and ambitions.
- 3. Candidates will perform a drawing task.
- 4. An interview with the Headmistress to discuss interests.

Drama Scholarship Selection Process:

- 1. Candidates will be asked to perform a monologue from a published playtext of their choice, lasting no more than two minutes.
- 2. A short interview with the Head of Drama, to discuss their interests, experiences and ambitions.
- 3. An interview with the Headmistress to discuss interests.

Music Scholarship Selection Process:

Each candidate may perform on either one or two instruments/voice, and will be auditioned on:

- 1. Two pieces of the candidate's own choice: either one piece on two different instruments, or two different pieces on the same instrument. (These should be of at least a good Grade 5 standard). The candidate may use either the school's accompanist or her own. If using an external accompanist, please supply details. If using the school's accompanist, please ensure a copy of the music score is sent to the Admissions Department at least one week before your audition.
- 2. Playing or Singing (Sight Reading).
- 3. Aural tests (these will be similar to those set by the Associated Board at the level the candidate has already achieved.)
- 4. A short meeting with the Director of Music and Performing Arts, to talk about musical ambitions.
- 5. An interview with the Headmistress to discuss interests.

Sports Scholarship Selection Process:

- 1. Candidates will be invited to demonstrate various skills including speed, agility, hand-eye coordination as well as general games ability.
- 2. A short interview with the Head of Sport, to discuss their interests, experiences and ambitions.
- 3. An interview with the Headmistress to discuss interests.
