Our Year 6 pupils enjoy full Senior School status, with many of their lessons being taught by specialist teachers for example Science, Physical Education, MFL and Food & Nutrition. They have full use of facilities in the Senior School science laboratories, Food & Nutrition and Textiles Departments, Art Rooms, Music Rooms and the Library. In addition they are encouraged to join in with activities designed to assist the transition to the Senior School such as the Middle School choir and various music groups.

Fees are payable in advance for each term. Any queries regarding fees should be submitted to the Business Manager.

A refundable deposit for breakages, lost library books, etc (£200) is also payable with the first term's fees.

ENTRANCE FEES

A non-refundable fee of \pounds 50 is charged for registration and entrance assessments, and should be enclosed with the registration form. On acceptance of a place, a non-refundable Acceptance Fee of \pounds 150 is charged.

EXTRA SUBJECTS

The majority of extra-curricular activities are offered at no extra charge, with some exceptions. Please speak to the Finance Office (01392 355990) for more information.

MEALS

Lunches are compulsory for all girls from Reception to Upper 3 (Yr 7) and are charged in advance on a termly basis at $\pounds4.20$ per day. Lunches are included in the fees for Reception pupils. Older girls can opt to have school lunches on a termly basis, or they may bring in a packed lunch each day.

A-LEVEL RESULTS

In the absence of any league tables or valuable statistics from 2020 results, our 2019 results are set out below.

The Maynard School has been ranked as the top Independent School in the South West and 60th nationally in The Telegraph's official A-level league tables in August 2019.

Our A-level cohort have posted a staggering set of A-level results this year with another 100% pass rate. Over 60% achieved A* – A with an impressive 44% scoring at least three straight A* or A grades in their subjects, bucking the national trend of 25.5% achieving an A grade or higher.

GCSE RESULTS

Our 2019 GCSE results were also outstanding - this year saw a whole raft of high achieving students with some excellent results including a total of 10 students who gained eight or more Grades 8-9. A further 15 girls (nearly a third of the year group at 30%) achieved seven or more Grades 8–9 making this The Maynard's best year since the new grading system was launched. The statistics speak for themselves with an enormous 46.7% achieving a Grade 8 or 9 and 92.3% gaining a 6 to 9 ($A^{**} - B$).

UNIVERSITY DESTINATIONS

We are delighted that each year our students gain places at the top UK universities for a wide variety of subjects.

Year on year, our students attend some of the most academically selective courses at top universities, from Aeronautical Engineering, Architecture, English, Medicine, Geography, Business, Art or Midwifery. Over 80% of girls obtain offers from Russell Group universities each year including Oxford, Cambridge, Durham, Imperial, UCL, St Andrews, Bristol and Edinburgh.

HOW TO APPLY TO THE MAYNARD



The prospect of joining a new school should be exciting and engaging for pupils and as stress-free as possible for parents. At The Maynard we try to make our admissions process as easy as possible. Depending on place availability, girls are welcome to join us at any stage of their academic career and at any time during the school year. We offer a number of Scholarships for entry into the Senior School and Sixth Form as well as Fee Assisted Places.

Once we have received your registration, we will request references and a copy of your daughter's most recent report from her current school.

ENTRANCE ASSESSMENTS



We want your daughter to enjoy her school years and so, to ensure the Maynard School is truly suited to her and will be the right place for her to flourish, from Year 3 upwards the application process includes written assessments.

We understand that, for some girls, this may be their first experience of a formal assessment so we aim to make the morning as relaxed and enjoyable as possible. Girls spend the morning taking our assessments and then join our current girls for lunch and afternoon lessons. We look for potential as well as current ability, and we advise that any extra coaching for the assessments is not necessary. Entrance Assessments can be arranged all year round although we do have set dates every January in the year of entry.

PRE-PREP

If you think your daughter would enjoy our caring learning environment, the next stage would be to book in for a Taster Session where she can get to meet some of our current girls and experience the Maynard's happy way of life! During a Taster Session we will carry out an informal observation to make sure your daughter would be suited to the School. We will consider interaction with adults and peers, any specific behavioural or individual needs, reading, drawing, practical handling activities,

Following your daughter's morning at the School, if we feel that the Pre-Prep would be the right setting for her, we would then be able to formally offer a place. Parents are then required to return the Acceptance Form to complete the entry procedure.

JUNIOR SCHOOL

Our 7+, 8+, 9+ and 10+ Entrance Assessments take place every January. If you are unable to attend this group event, you can sit an individual entrance assessment at any time throughout the year.

SENIOR SCHOOL

Our 11+ and 13+ School group Entrance Assessment Days take place every January. If you are unable to attend this group event, you can sit an individual entrance assessment at any time throughout the year. Entrance Assessments to Years 7 (U3) consist of two papers – English and Mathematics as well as an online Reasoning Paper. Candidates for Years 8, 9 and 10 (L4, U4 and L5) sit an additional Science paper.

SIXTH FORM

Following registration, your daughter will be invited for an interview with the Headmistress, the Director of the Sixth Form and any other relevant Heads of Departments. We will also write to your daughter's current school to request a reference, latest report and predicted GCSE grades.

If we are then able to offer a place, please note that this is conditional upon your daughter reaching the minimum entry requirements for entry into our Sixth Form, namely at least six grade 6 GCSEs, a minimum of a grade 6 in both Maths and English GCSE and a grade 7 in the subjects to be taken at A-level. Students will always be considered on their individual merits.

OFFERS

Offers of a place are made in writing as soon as possible after the Entrance Assessment has been taken. We then ask parents to sign the accompanying Acceptance Form, having read the Terms & Conditions booklet, and pay an Acceptance fee which secures a place for your daughter.

TASTER DAYS

Your daughter may also like to come on a Taster Day to meet some of her prospective classmates and to sense a real 'feel' for the unique Maynard way of life. We hold annual group Taster Days for Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 and for Upper 3 (Year 7) and Upper 4 (Year 9) every autumn as well as there being the opportunity for your daughter to enjoy a Taster afternoon on the day of her Individual Assessment.
