The Maynard Award Programme is an initiative which mirrors the strong ethos of The Maynard School – that an excellent education should be accessible to the most talented and gifted girls, regardless of household income.

We offer two 100% Sixth Form Maynard Award Scholarships each year for outstanding students from the state sector who are eligible for a means tested bursary. These will be awarded to girls who can demonstrate outstanding academic and/or extracurricular achievements which would further enhance our vibrant community, exemplifying the ethos of our school.

BURSARIES

The Maynard also offers a range of means tested bursaries which can be stand alone or applied for in conjunction with a Scholarship. If you are applying for a Maynard Award you must also complete a bursary application as this is an integral part of the process.

HOW TO APPLY

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL CANDIDATES

- Scholarships and Maynard Awards are offered by The Maynard School to recognise and encourage excellence.
- Unless otherwise stated, scholarships are worth 10% of the tuition fees.
- Students can apply for a means tested bursary of up to 45% fee remission.
- If scholarships or awards are oversubscribed, a short-listing process will be implemented.
- The school reserves the right not to award a scholarship or award if, in the opinion of the selection panel, no candidates meet the required standard. There is no appeals process.
- Sixth Form scholarships are awarded for the duration of the Sixth Form.
- Scholarships and awards are reviewed annually, and scholars will be expected to participate regularly in relevant school activities, maintaining standards of attainment and conduct to continue their scholarship in future years.
- A scholarship or award may be withdrawn or reduced if, in the opinion of the Headmistress, the student's attendance, progress or behaviour no longer merits the continuation of the scholarship or award.

Those receiving scholarships or awards are expected to make a real contribution to the academic life of the school as a whole, and to be a role model for younger girls. These responsibilities are intended to help the scholars or those gaining awards develop transferable skills that will be important in their future careers.
