

JOIN AS A SOLDIER


AGES
16-17

ARMY FOUNDATION COLLEGE HARROGATE

-  23 or 49 weeks, with intakes in March and September each year.
-  Get paid £800-£1,000 a month.

If you're 16 or 17 you'll train at AFC Harrogate as a junior soldier. You'll learn all the skills you need, from map reading to how to handle a weapon. After Harrogate, you will do your Trade Training before joining your unit.

BASIC TRAINING

-  Soldier Training (except infantry) **14 weeks** followed by role-specific training.
-  Infantry Training **26-28 weeks**.
-  Annual salary – starting from over **£18,500** rising to over **£23,000** after 26 weeks' training.

INITIAL SOLDIER (BASIC) TRAINING

Here, you will learn the skills to become a soldier. The length of your Basic Training depends which part of the Army you join. While there, you'll have 'down time' including time for sport and adventure training and some time off to go home.

STUDENT NURSE

Study Nursing as a Soldier

Once you've finished Basic Training, you'll then complete a BSc (Hons) in Adult or Mental Health Nursing at Birmingham City University. Not only will your **tuition fees be paid by the Army**, but you'll earn a salary of over £23,000 while you study. Alternatively, you can **study nursing as a civilian** and receive a bursary worth up to £42,000.



* The requirements for joining as a soldier vary from no qualifications to degree-level, depending on your role.



QUALIFY WITH AN APPRENTICESHIP



LOCAL COLLEGE OR SIXTH FORM

ARMY SIXTH FORM SCHOLARSHIP
Available to those studying two years of further education at school or college and wishing to join the Army as an Officer*. You will receive **£3,000** in Year 13/S6/Upper Sixth and a Standard Bursary at university. You can apply to upgrade to another bursary if you are eligible. 40 ALIS points from 7 GCSE's and SNQ equivalent.

ARMY OFFICER INTERNSHIP

Experience the role of an Army Officer while on a gap year before, during or after university. After completion of a 9-week Army Reserve Commissioning Course, it's an 'internship' with no commitment after the GYC if so desired. The salary is around **£18,000**.

UNIVERSITY

ARMY UNDERGRADUATE BURSARY (STANDARD)
£6,000 for students on three year degree courses, or **£7,000** on four year degree courses.

DEFENCE STEM UNDERGRADUATE SPONSORSHIP (DSUS)

Up to **£42,750** (£5k yearly bursary + tuition fees) for students on STEM degree courses commissioning into Royal Engineers, Royal Signals, Royal Logistics Corps, Royal Electrical and Mechanical Engineers or Intelligence Corps.

ANNUAL SALARY IN EXCESS OF **£28,500**, RISING TO OVER **£37,000** UPON COMMISSIONING.



FULLY FUNDED DEGREE

Instead of heading off to university, you could gain a degree while you serve. Your training at Sandhurst counts towards a BSc in Leadership and Strategic Studies, offered by the University of Reading's Henley Business School. You'll carry on with your studies as your career continues beyond the Academy and you will not have to pay any fees.

ARMY UNDERGRADUATE BURSARY (ENHANCED)

£24,000 for students with high grade A-Levels, score well at AOSB, and on track to achieve a 2:1 degree or higher.

PROFESSIONALLY QUALIFIED OFFICER (PQO) BURSARY

Up to **£75,000** available for students at Medical School, as potential Medical, Dental, Veterinary, Pharmacy and Nursing Officers.

The Royal Military Academy Sandhurst in Surrey is where all officers in the British Army are trained to take on the responsibilities of leading the soldiers under their command. The Commissioning Course covers military skills and practical and academic subjects while developing your leadership skills.

* The educational requirements for joining as an officer are: 35 ALIS points at GCSE (34 ALIS points for SNOs) and 72 UCAS points at A level (or equivalent).
